Philosophy

- Kohl's US Youth Soccer American Cup was created to enhance the accomplishments of recreational players and provides recreational youth soccer players a fun, family-like atmosphere. The goal is to foster stimulation and excitement about soccer in an effort to increase the recreational player's interest in and love for the game.
- Kohl's American Cup is open to **recreational players** registered with a US Youth Soccer State Association.
- A league or club may decide which teams can enter Kohl's American Cup. Teams should be created so that every player was accepted and assigned to a roster regardless of ability. Every recreational player shall have equal opportunity to participate in every game. No tryouts, invitations or recruiting may be used.

- All applications will come through State Office (online application through Secure Website)
- Teams may attend a Kohl's American Cup outside of their Region
- Kohl's Interactive Truck may be on-site with inflatables and games for whole family
- **Under-8 to Under-14; Boys & Girls**
- Recreation players or Rec All-Stars (within club only)
- **\$125 entry fee (inclusive of referee fees)**
- Open entry, one or two-day festival format; 3 games guaranteed per team (play on only one day to minimize travel costs)
- No scores are kept, no champions crowned
- *Each participant will receive Kohl's premium items, a Kohl's certificate and Kohl's US Youth Soccer American Cup t-shirt*
- **APPLICATION DEADLINE: On-line application deadline is Friday, April 2, 2010. Deadline to have entry fee to FYSA is Friday, April 9, 2010.**
